Dine In Project Options

Painting

Students will have an opportunity to learn basic color theory and how to use color and pattern to create a pleasing composition.

Clay

Students will have a chance to work with air-dry clay to create a simple pot using traditional methods. This technique can be adapted to working with kiln-fired clay in the classroom.

Printmaking

Students will learn the basics of printmaking and teachers may choose from a variety of projects. Options include copper "etchings", foam printing, or block printing. (Choose option by circling it.) Screenprinting may be available for groups of 10 or less for a fee of \$5 per student, based on instructor availability.

Sculpture

Students will review how surface decoration and proportion are used in sculptural art forms and will incorporate those principals in a creation of their own design. (Media varies.)

Note to teachers & organization leaders:

All visits are honored on a first-come-first-served basis.

You are welcome to request a special appointment for either program option if you don't see a date listed that works for you - just make a note on this form and mail back to us or give us a call. We will do our best to honor your request, but please keep in mind that all special requests are based on availability.

When visiting us

- Students who require special attention should be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- If your group exceeds 25 students, it may be split into two. Please be prepared to do so if this is necessary.
- **Please limit your group to 40 students.**
- During colder weather and on rainy days, please allow your students to leave their jackets on the bus as it will allow for a more efficient visit. It is a short distance between the bus drop-off point and our entrance. Students will meet in the foyer and then proceed upstairs to the Gallery.
- Students will be asked to follow certain rules of conduct when in our gallery.

When we visit you

- We will supply most project materials, however, you may be asked to provide certain staple items such as scissors, glue, pencils, etc. We will notify you of this in advance.

Delivery Project Options

Abstract Collage

Students will learn about collage artists and how they can use paper, line, color, and shape to create a unique piece of artwork.

Art and Culture

Students will be introduced to art from cultures around the world and will create a piece of work in that style. If your class is studying a particular culture, let us know and we'll personalize the project for you.

Music, Color and Art

Students will learn how to use music as inspiration for their art and how to use color to express a mood or feeling.

Expressive Drawing

Students will learn about Expressionism and how to use color and line to make an expressive masterpiece. Students will work with charcoal and pastels.
